

CHECKLIST: TOILET LEAKS

Toilets are the single biggest water guzzler in a home. A leaky toilet can waste up to 200 gallons of water a day!

1. Write in the location of each toilet in your home.
2. Open the dye tablets and drop them in the rear tank of the toilet. Wait 20 minutes.
3. Circle “Clear” or “Dyed” regarding the dye tablet test for each toilet. **If a toilet(s) is “Clear”, there is no leak and you can skip Step #4.**
